CPD Update for CISRS Instructors

Tony Barry, CISRS Compliance Manager hosted two lunchtime webinar sessions last week in order to bring the CISRS instructors up to speed with the changes to the revised CPD course programme ahead of the launch of CPD Phase 2 Monday 1st of August.

45 instructors from CISRS training providers across the UK attended the webinars which included a PowerPoint presentation and a question and answer session. Some of the areas which have changed include additional content on health, including HAVS and Noise, Ties and Anchors, Temporary works and increased inspection content. Several NASC Guidance notes are due for the imminent launch including SG4, SG6 and TG1, these will all be included with the course content as soon as they are available.

Attendance at the sessions is mandatory for any instructor looking to deliver CPD Phase 2, as such they were delivered over lunchtime to allow for maximum instructor attendance and minimum disruption to the delivery of training.
