CISRS Overseas Training continues to thrive in Nepal

CISRS Auditor Trevor Donoghue has just returned to the UK after completing 2 successful annual accreditation compliance audits in Kathmandu, Nepal.

Both Safety and Access/Aecor International and Simian/Interscaff received a clean bill of health during their respective visits and have been granted a further 12 months accreditation.

Around 1300 operatives have completed CISRS OSTS training in the region in since the last audit.

Ian Fyall Managing Director of Simian International who accompanied CISRS during their centre audit said:

It's great to get back out to Nepal and see how the centre has returned to normality after the Covid pandemic. Over the past year around 500 people have come through the centre, completing CISRS OSTS training and then making their way to the middle east to change theirs and their family's lives. It is a pleasure to see such a hardworking, friendly country succeed."

The Simian Interscaff Centre was accredited for CISRS OSTS Level 1, 2, Basic and Advanced Inspection and Scaffolding Supervisor Training.
